The creche is available today for pre-primary aged children.




The creche is for pre-primary school aged children. All children will need to accompanied by their adult in the creche. There is an audio link to the service in creche.

If you can't be with us in person and are interested in sharing communion at home, please do be in touch with Mike.


Eating together at Cornerstone




When coming forward to receive Communion, depending on how you would like to receive the wine, please stand in the appropriate space.
