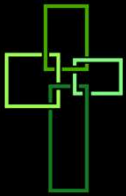

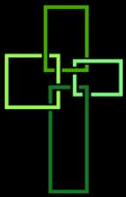
Regular notices...

The creche will be available during all the above services.

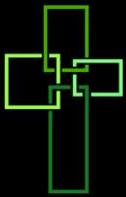

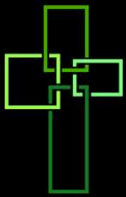

Gluten free bread is not currently available but can be made so next time. Please speak to one of the Elders.

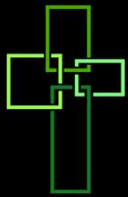
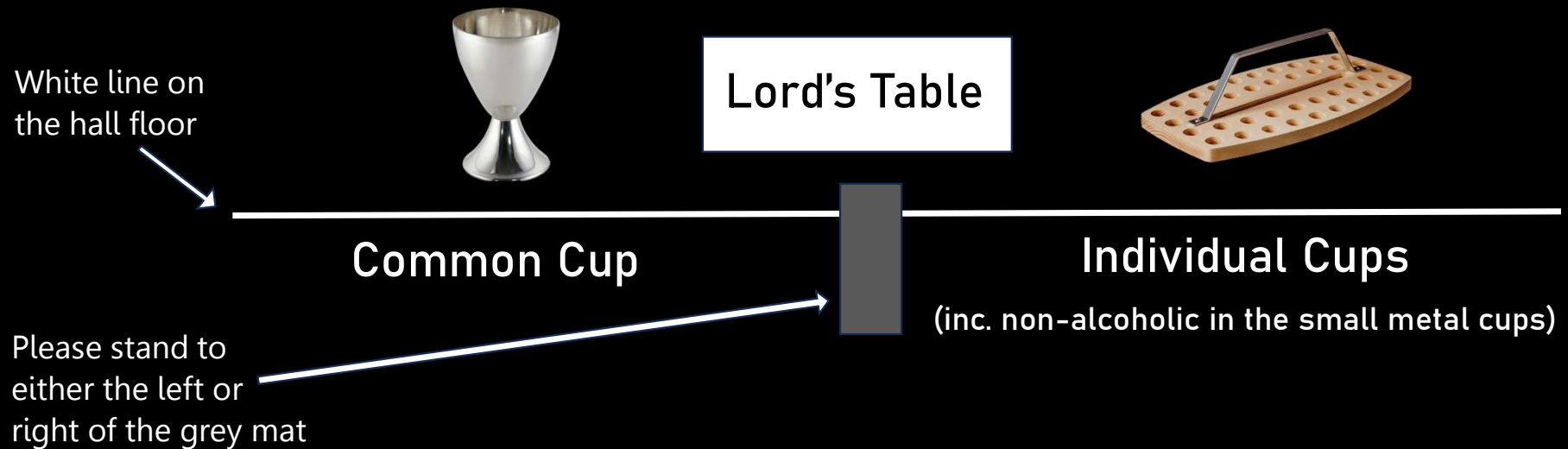
If you can't be with us in person and are interested in sharing communion at home, please do be in touch with Mike.

The Lord's Supper is today

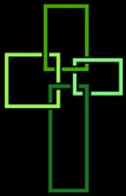


When coming forward to receive Communion, depending on how you would like to receive the wine, please stand in the appropriate space.

- There is always a vegetarian option. For any other dietary requirements, please have a word with anyone on the Food Serving Team.

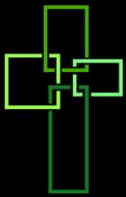

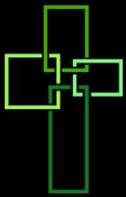
Good Friday outreach

If you are interested in helping out with this please speak to Jill Brock or Diana Cook.

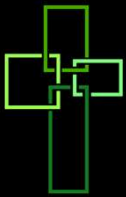

Book Table

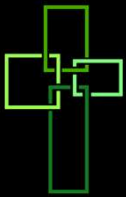
Reading good Bible-based Christian books is one good way to further engage with Jesus. The book table is here to help you do this.
